

THEMATIC AREAS AND STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

Our work will be clustered around six main thematic areas with strategic objectives, which integrate both policy and programmatic work.

Thematic Area	Strategic Objective
Education	Somali children, in particular the most marginalized and those affected by humanitarian situations, are provided with inclusive and equitable quality education and learning opportunities.
Health and Nutrition	Increased access to quality and range of health and nutrition care services including comprehensive maternal and child health care services, awareness on disease prevention and promotion of healthy lifestyles.
Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)	Improved access to clean and safe water, hygiene and sanitation services for the target poor communities.
Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL)	To improve the productivity of farmers through technology transfer and to address emergency food security needs.
Youth Empowerment	Youth, especially those from vulnerable households/families have increased access to demand-driven vocational skill training and business development services that enhance their employability and access to sustainable income.
Protection of Children in Emergencies	Reduced vulnerability and increased resilience of crisis-affected families and community in Somalia to care for and protect children through creation of employment opportunities and to sustainable access to basic service.
